Trauma-Biohazard Scene Waste Management Practitioners

A trauma scene waste management practitioner is a person who undertakes as a commercial activity the removal of human blood, human body fluids, and other associated residues from the scene of a serious human injury, illness, or death. A practitioner shall register with the California Department of Public Health and shall follow Chapter 9.5, commencing with Section 118321, of the California Health and Safety Code.

From the California Victim Compensation Board (CalVCB)

When a crime occurs in a residence or vehicle, CalVCB may reimburse any individual who pays, or assumes the obligation to pay, reasonable costs to clean the scene of the crime in an amount not to exceed \$1,709. (GC § 13957(a)(9))

The Board may only reimburse crime scene cleanup expenses provided by an individual or company registered as a trauma scene waste management practitioner with the California Department of Public Health. CalVCB can only pay for the cleanup of biohazard materials and not for damaged property. Use the above link or the below QR code to go to the CalVCB website.
